

**Beginning Friday August 13**, Ind. 149/Max Mochal Hwy will be closed at the CSX railroad grade-crossing, just south of US Highway 20 in Burns Harbor. This closure is expected to remain **in effect through the end of October** while CSX improves the crossing and replaces track there. Although Ind. 149/Max Mochal Hwy. will be closed at the crossing by a concrete barrier, local traffic will have access to Ind. 149/Max Mochal Hwy. on either side of the closure. The intersection of Ind. 149/Max Mochal Hwy. and Old Porter Road may also be closed intermittently.

Here are a few alternate routes that can be used to access Duneland Falls:

From Rt. 6, go northbound on County Road 200 West to County Road 1050 North. Take County Road 1050 North westbound to 149/Max Mochal Hwy. Duneland Falls is ¼ mile north of County Road 1050 North.

From McCool, go eastbound on Lenburg Road. to 149/Max Mochal Hwy. Duneland Falls is ¼ mile north of Lenburg Road.

From US Hwy 20 westbound or eastbound, turn onto Verplank Road (1/4 mile east of 149/Max Mochal Hwy.) and follow to County Road 200 West/ South Babcock Road. Take County Road 200 West/South Babcock Road. Southbound to County Road 1050 North. Take County Road

1050 North westbound to 149/Max Mochal Hwy. Duneland falls is ¼ mile north of County Road 1050 North.
